I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Destroyer-Class vessel, *HMS Datanet*, successfully intercepted and neutralized a major enemy naval expeditionary group attempting a high-value coastal landing in [Redacted]. Utilizing superior positioning, main gun proficiency, and aggressive anti-submarine tactics, **11 (Eleven)** confirmed enemy vessels were sunk, including a Capital Ship and 4 (Four) Nakki Submarines. The invasion attempt was fully aborted, securing the coastal region and denying the enemy a critical strategic foothold.

II. NARRATIVE OF ACTION

2.1. Initial Contact and Classification

Responding to the invasion signal from The Fingers. Land forces confirmed the presence of large transport vessels—one Longhook and one Bluefin—suggesting an immediate, large-scale landing objective.

2.2. Main Surface Engagement

HMS Datanet initiated the engagement by closing range on the largest escort vessel, identified as an enemy Battleship [Redacted], supported by a Frigate. The main 120mm guns were focused on disabling the Battleship's propulsion and primary ordnance, achieving a critical hit to the engine room, forcing the massive vessel to list and slow.

Simultaneously, the Frigate was engaged and dispatched rapidly using HE shells, followed by a direct

return to fire on the crippled Battleship. The Battleship was sunk.

The Landing Ships, the Longhook and Bluefin, attempted to break formation and beach their cargo. Precision targeting by *HMS Datanet* disabled the Longhook first, ensuring its cargo was lost. The larger Bluefin was chased down and sunk shortly thereafter.

2.3. Anti-Submarine Warfare

Following the neutralization of the surface combatants, sonar reported acoustic signatures—4 (Four) surfaced Nakki-Class Submarines closing on *HMS Datanet*. The vessel immediately shifted to ASW protocol.

The Destroyer engaged them one by one firing main 120mm guns. The crew demonstrated exceptional coordination, successfully eliminating all 4 (Four) Submarines.
